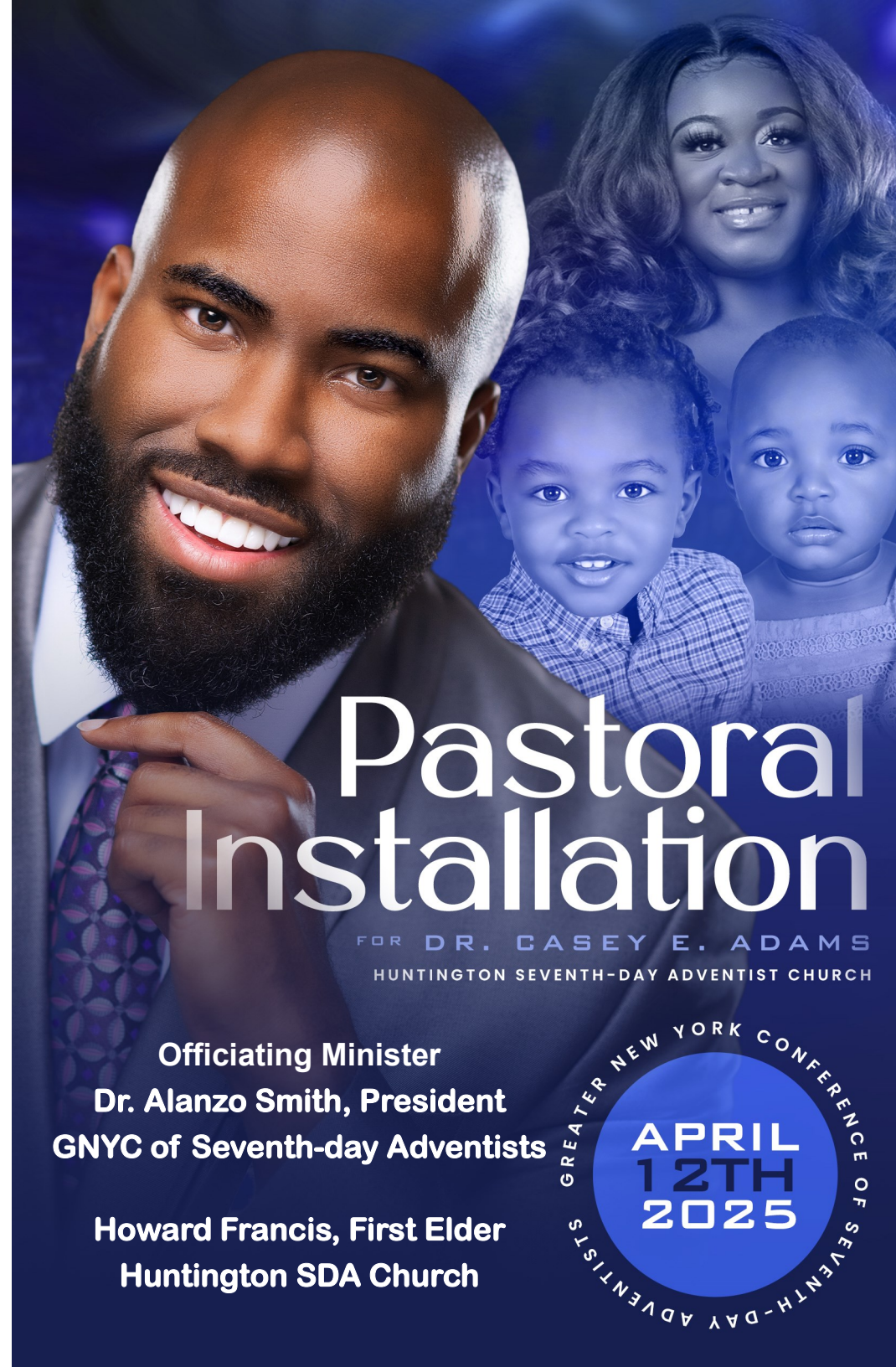

**Lesson: The Genesis Foundation**

**Memory Text:** “The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, ‘Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!’” (John 1:29, NKJV).

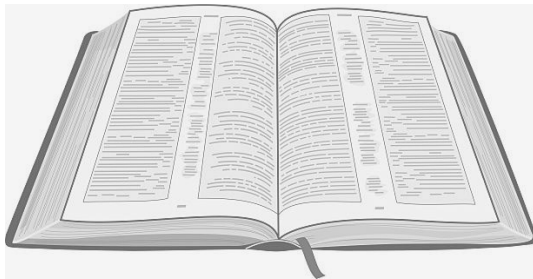
