- •You may choose to kneel at the rail or remain standing. Hold out your open hands to receive the communion bread. Gluten-free bread is available, simply tell the server. Another server will then place the communion cup on the altar rail. You may partake of the elements as they are served.
- •Feel free to remain at the altar for a brief time of prayer after you have communed, keeping in mind that others will be coming behind you.
- •There are baskets provided at the altar rails for you to dispose of your used communion cup.
- •If you desire to have communion served to you in your seat for any reason, please raise your hand and let the servers know.




Join us at both services on Sunday, June 1st for a special Youth Sunday. Our youth will provide leadership in the service, and we'll also honor those graduating from High School or College.


